

ATROPINE 10

injectable solution
50 ml

Composition:

Each ml contains: 1 mg atropine sulphate.

Indications:

Atropine is primarily used as a preanesthetic, to prevent bradycardia and reduce airway secretions, and as emergency therapy of dyspneic animals with organophosphate intoxication. Atropine is also used for acute bronchodilation in horses.



Dosage and administration:

Average dosage: 3 – 7 μ l (microliter) 'Atropine 10' per kg bodyweight. Administer parenterally by subcutaneous, intramuscular or intravenous injection.

Storage:

Store between 8 and 15 °C and protected from light.
